MISSION


To provide advocacy and leadership on pluralistic and demand-driven rural advisory services for sustainable development

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES



ADVOCACY

- Increase network capacity for policy dialogue and advocacy;
- Increased financial and strategic partnerships are developed;
- Increased sensitivity of gender and youth issues among partners;
- Active engagement in policy formulation.



KNOWLEDGE SHARING

- Strengthen the role of networks in A(K)IS knowledge sharing;
- Facilitate peer-to-peer knowledge exchange;
- Systematized knowledge sharing initiatives among networks;
- Knowledge about relevance of gender sensitive RAS and Youth in Ag produced and shared;
- Guidance for effective knowledge management established and shared.



PROFESSIONALISATION
